
'Nagauta' is one of Shamisen music basically composed with song and Shamisen play. It developed as an accompaniment of 'Kabuki play' (Japanese traditional opera)

in Edo era (17C-19C).

Shamisen is three-stringed Japanese traditional musical instrument.

To play 'Shamisen', the strings are plucked with a plectrum.

'Mai' is traditional Japanese dance.
