

**‘Sado’**, Japanese tea ceremony, also called the **Way of Tea**, is a Japanese cultural activity involving the ceremonial preparation and presentation of **Macha**, powdered green tea. The manner in which it is performed, or the art of its performance, is called **Otemae**. **Zen Buddhism** was a primary influence in the development of the Japanese tea ceremony. The tea is usually served with Japanese confections.
