'Sado', Japanese tea ceremony, also called the Way of Tea, is a Japanese cultural activity involving the ceremonial preparation and presentation of Macha, powdered green tea. The manner in which it is performed, or the art of its performance, is called Otemae. Zhen Buddhism was a primary influence in the development of the Japanese tea ceremony. The tea is usually served with Japanese confections.
