

Taiko-en Japanese garden

Banquet place, Taiko-en, is an oasis in the city and historic property in 5.7 acre impressive Japanese garden in traditional Tsukiyama-shiki Kaiyu-style. The garden expresses beauty throughout the year, together with its historic and distinguished buildings. For example, 13-layered stone Pagoda is built in the Kamakura period (1151-1333) and their upper part is still amazingly well preserved. Furthermore, they consists of historical stone statues as well as stone bridge, which is said that to be the largest stone bridge from a single slab of rock in western japan. With the traditional garden and architecture as a backdrop, Taiko-en is one of Japan's most prestigious banquet venues.

1. Walk to the Tenjin-bashi and cross the Yodo river to the north.
2. Turn right at Minami-Temma park.
(Enjoy Sakura beauty !)
3. Turn left at the bridge and go straight about 500 m.
4. Turn right and the place is on the left side.
