<Background and Issues to be discussed>

IP cases are generally more complex than other commercial disputes, and their adjudication requires not only legal but also specialist technical knowledge.

A specialized IP court dedicated to handling such cases will help reduce judicial errors and increase consistency and predictability, potentially fostering a more favorable environment for innovation and foreign investment.

This panel discussion will elucidate the differences and similarities among the three IP Courts. It will also examine the advantages and disadvantages of the IP court regimes with the aim to improve on the existing IP systems.
