Japan is currently facing challenges such as a declining population, over-centralization in Tokyo, and the COVID-19 pandemic. In particular, various regions of Japan continue to experience slowing economies and acceleration in their population decline. To overcome these challenges, the Japanese government is making efforts at "regional revitalization" and is promoting regional revitalization that uses the SDGs as its driving force.

In the International Forum on SDGs for Regional Revitalization 2021, we will attempt to further promote SDG-driven regional revitalization. We will describe SDG initiatives being undertaken in cities in Japan and elsewhere, and innovative practices in regional revitalization. Participants will learn how the technologies and know-how of Japanese companies have been used abroad to solve regional problems. In addition, we will show some of the business models that are being practiced to achieve the SDGs. Our objective is to use the Forum as a jumping-off point, to accelerate efforts toward sustainable development, and to broaden the variety of initiatives to achieve regional economic revitalization at home and abroad.
